Learning Objectives

Teaching Tasks

- Identify each animal and classify it based on its characteristics.

Session Structure

Introduction (5 minutes)

- Brief explanation of the activity and review of the content to be worked on.

Development (30 minutes)

- Represent different animals using Artec blocks or similar materials.
- Classify animals into their corresponding groups based on their characteristics.

Closure (10 minutes)

- Review and reflective questions about the activity.

- Develop fine motor skills.
